Sunday 9AM Bible Study: A Longer Look at the Lessons:



PRIVATE HOME COMMUNION:





Tax returns, tax return supporting documents (if you do not file a return), record of mortgage payment	Indefinitely
Record of loan payment	Seven years
Tax return supporting documents (if you do not report income)	Six years
Tax return supporting documents	Three years
Quarterly investment records, quarterly retirement savings statements, credit card	One year
statements, pay stubs, medical bills, receipts for large purchases (or until the warranty expires)	
Credit cards bills (or until paid), receipts	One month
Utility bills	Until processed
Loan documents	Until paid
Home and auto insurance documents	Until you receive new ones
Home improvement records	While you hold the house
