NOTES FROM FRANKLIN AVE MISSION (FAM)

Mercy House has 3 Moms at the moment. They may have a 4th one soon.

FAM will be downsizing the **Clothing Closet**. Sometime in May they are going to have a large garage sale/give away to reduce inventory. They are working on opening a laundromat along with showers to help reduce the need for fresh clothing.

The **items they can still use** are baby wipes, shampoo & conditioner and small travel sizes of deodorant. They also always need all sizes of socks and underwear.


Clean & Green will be a combination of what they have done in the past and what was done during Covid. We would like Church teams to sign up to mow at least 1 Saturday during the summer.

3 Phase plans are underway but we don't know when we will start. Phase 1- 60 people will be allowed in for inside dining. Phase 2 will be up to 90 people. Phase 3 will be up to 120. We will also have outside dining and early take out. We are building more picnic tables for outside dining.

The **new custodial** program is underway. We have 2 people hired for the 3-month program, with the hope at the end of the 3 months they will have learned the skills needed to obtain full time employment.


