





Our next Congregational Meeting will be on Sunday, August 29th, following the Worship Service.

Brothers and Sisters in Christ,

There continues to be worry and concern over masking, social distancing, and vaccination status among our membership. President Harrison addressed these issues in a letter sent out earlier this year. I would like to share with you the following highlights.

Should I take the COVID-19 vaccine? This is a question only you can answer. Some may choose not to take the vaccine because of concerns over its relation to abortion or fear of possible health complications. Others may take it in spite of such reservations out of concern for their own health or that of their neighbor. Since neither Scripture nor the Synod has explicitly addressed this issue, it remains a matter of Christian freedom where you must choose according to your individual conscience.

How should I talk about the vaccine with others who disagree with my view of it? In a sensitive issue of this nature, we remember the words of St. James: "Let every person be quick to hear, slow to speak, slow to anger" (James 1:19). Listen carefully and openly to the points of others. Consider them. Share your positions patiently and objectively. Reflect upon your own penchant for error. Forgive others where they sin against you and ask for forgiveness where you wrong them.

1 Corinthians 10:23-24 ²³ "All things are lawful," but not all things are helpful. "All things are lawful," but not all things build up. ²⁴ Let no one seek his own good, but the good of his neighbor.

Romans 14:13 Therefore let us not pass judgment on one another any longer, but rather decide never to put a stumbling block or hindrance in the way of a brother.

Finally, I would encourage each of you to turn to the LORD in prayer when you feel worried or afraid about COVID attacking you or someone you love. Remember our God is far greater and stronger than even the Delta variant. Masking, social distancing, and vaccines are gracious gifts from Him that He works through, but He is not bound by these as His only means of protecting you. As you do His will, worshiping Him as a member of His Church, ask Him to make clear to you what He has provided for your protection. Then entrust all the rest, including the vaccination status of your brother in Christ, over to His protection and care. Love your brothers and sisters in Christ with the same love that Christ Jesus has shared with you.

PHONE A FRIEND/GREETING CARD MINISTRY


