Franklin Ave. Mission Needs and News

<u>Temporary Closure of Luke Clinic in Flint</u> (At Franklin Avenue Mission)

For the past two years the Luke Clinic-Flint (operating at Franklin Avenue Mission) has been dedicated to serving some of the most vulnerable people in the community: mothers, and their newborn children. However, due to a shortage of qualified medical personnel Luke Clinic finds itself unable to sustain both their Flint Clinic and Detroit Clinic, and maintain quality, compassionate, relationship-based care. The Clinic has also reached a point financially where it has become increasingly difficult to maintain both campuses despite grants, donations, and community support geared to cover their operational costs.

Therefore, the decision has been made to temporarily close the Flint Clinic at Franklin Avenue Mission and focus on their Detroit Clinic where there is a greater need. They are exploring options to ensure current patients can transition to other health care providers smoothly and continue to have their medical needs met. Patients without insurance will be offered transportation assistance to allow them to be seen at the Detroit Clinic.

Once they have stabilized the staffing and financial issues, they look to reopen the Flint Clinic. During this time of closure, they will act as a clearing house for patients who call to initiate care and will continue to work with local pregnancy care centers and other agencies to help support women and children seeking medical care.

Please join me in prayer for the Luke Clinic, its staff, and those patients it serves, that the Lord who can do all things would provide the means, funds, and staff so that they can reopen soon. May our Lord show us how we can help as His Church to this end. (*Please see the letter posted in on the Fellowship Hall Bulletin Board*)



ZEFFY- ON LINE GIVING

LOG has changed the platform we use to process electronic payments. We were using Kindred and were recently notified that in addition to the regular batch charges, we were going to be charged \$9.99 fee per month. For the entire year of 2022, we paid \$164 in Kindred fees. For six months in 2023, we have already paid \$147. Glenda just received another notice of an increase to \$19.99/ month in addition to the other fees. Because of this, the Church Council looked at alternative platforms to process our electronic payments. Zeffy was chosen since there are no fees to you or to the Church. Zeffy is a non-profit organization that was formed to help other non-profit organizations.

If you would like to give on our website, just click the "Give Now Lamb of God Lutheran Church" button and then click on "Give to Lamb of God Church Now." From there, you can choose a one-time donation, monthly donation or a yearly donation. There are set amounts you can select or you can type in any amount. On your first donation, you'll have to enter your checking account information or a debit or credit account number. The Zeffy website uses Stripe to verify your checking account or credit card information. You can also donate via Apple Pay / Google Pay. Each time you make a donation to LOG, you will also be asked to make a donation to Zeffy. You do not have to do this but can if you would like to support Zeffy as well. You will receive an email receipt with each donation. If you have any problems or need any help setting up your Zeffy account, please see Wendy or Glenda.
