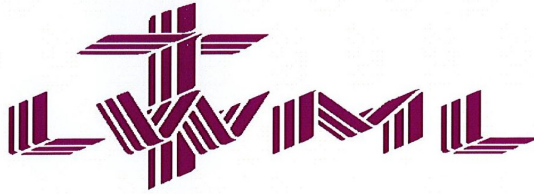

### **MARK YOUR CALENDAR**

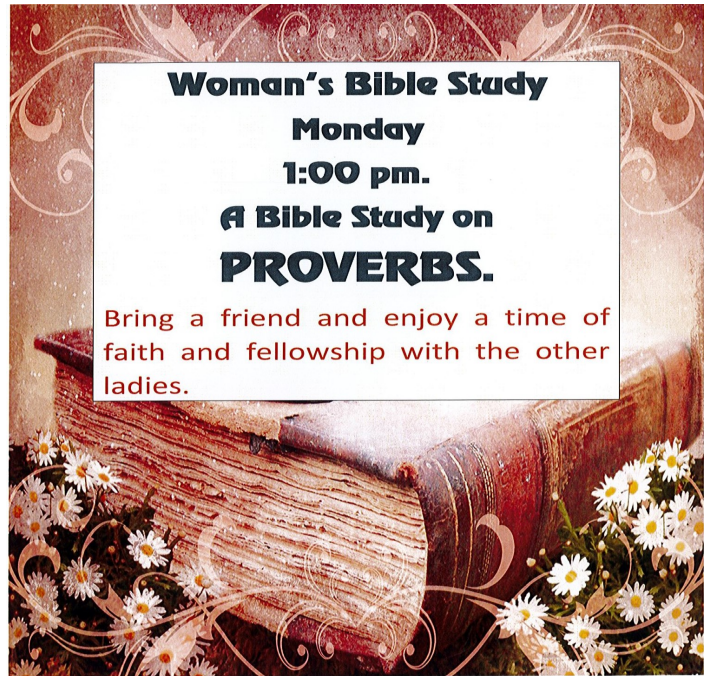
**Our turn to help serve at Franklin Ave. Mission will be on Tuesday and Thursday, August 10 & 12, at 4:00—6:30 pm.**

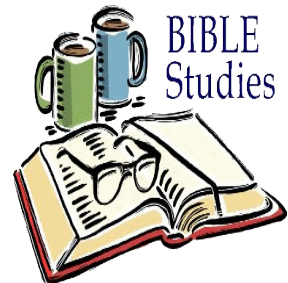

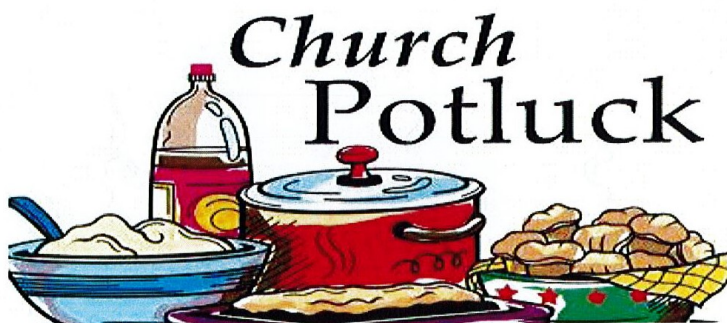
