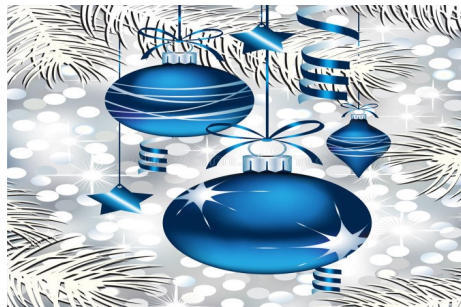
TOYS FOR TOTS

Each member is able to apply for two cards a year—which will end in December and you can re apply in January of 2021. If you have not applied to use your Thrivent Cards—now is the time.

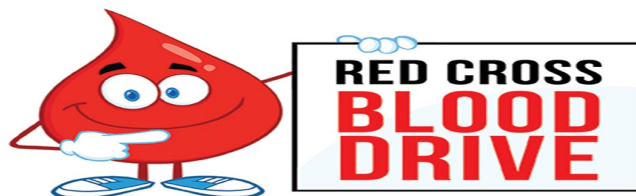
