



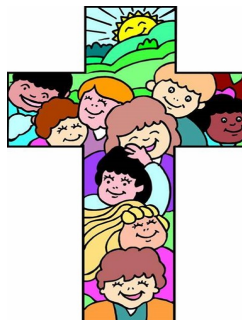

Beginning Ash Wednesday (February 17th, 2021)

In the Book of Joel, the prophet paints a vivid picture of the coming judgment of God, the Day of the Lord. But right in the middle of this frightening portent, we find a tender invitation from the Lord: "Return to the Lord your God, for He is gracious and merciful, slow to anger, and abounding in steadfast love; and He relents over disaster" During this season of Lent, we will consider the theme "Return to the Lord" and examine how the call to return played out in practical ways for the people who walked alongside Christ during His Passion.
