

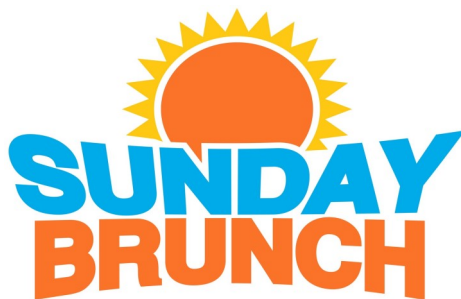

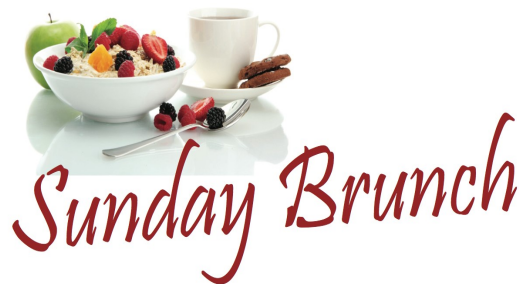


The flowers on the Altar this morning were given to the glory of God, from Rev Art & Joan Reich, in celebration for the birthday of Susan Marshan

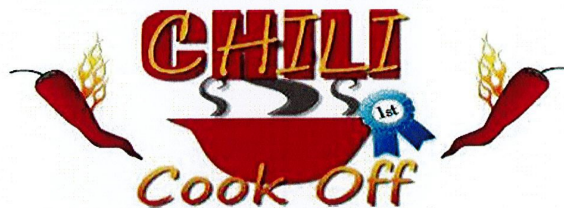

Formula & Food

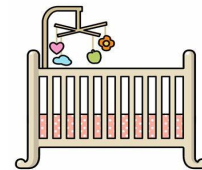
Any other baby items you know a baby could use.

Maternity Clothes (any size)

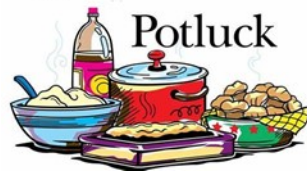
Yarn (given to nursing homes so that the residents can make booties, blankets, etc.)
