This is one way in which we can show our strong **PRO-LIFE** support. Let's do what we can to make the crib overflow.

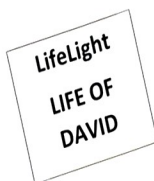


WOMEN'S BIBLE STUDY

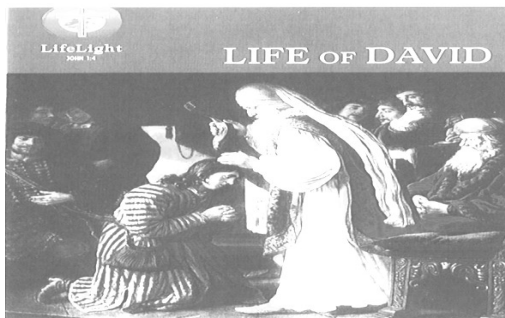

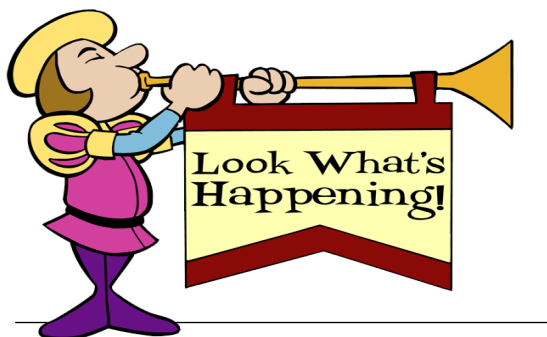
