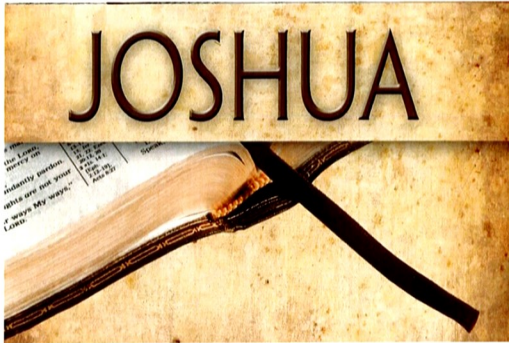
Wanted: Volunteers to Sponsor our Sunday Fellowship Hour

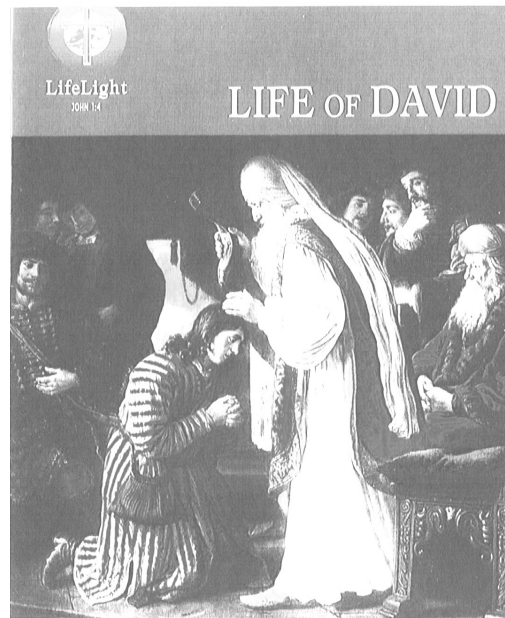

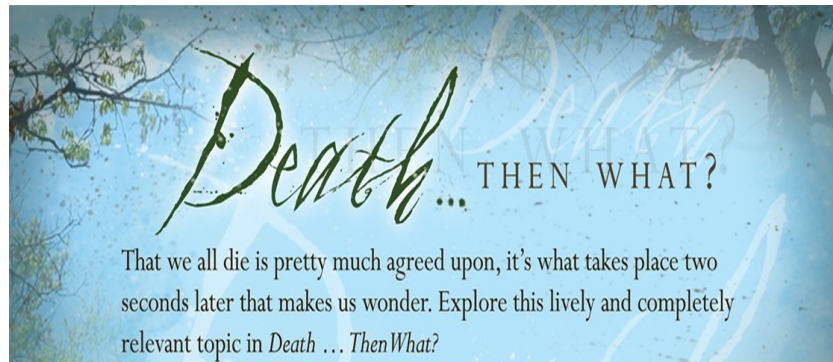


CHILDREN'S CHURCH RETURNS SUNDAY MORNING

PHONE A FRIEND/GREETING CARD MINISTRY

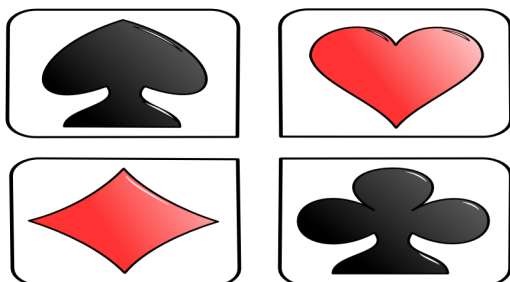
