This is one way in which we can show our strong **PRO-LIFE** support. Let's do what we can to make the crib overflow.






WOMEN'S BIBLE STUDY

Join us on Monday, at 1:00 pm.


A new Bible Study entitled "HEBREWS—The fulfillment of faith". This is a study of one of the most profound books of the New Testa-


