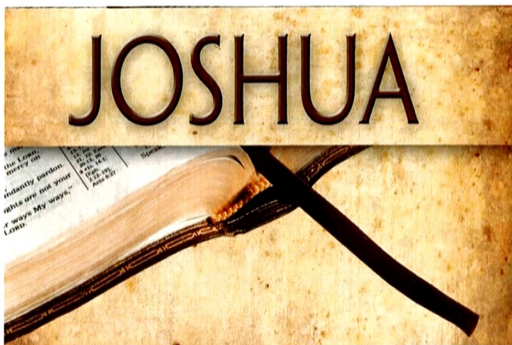
## **Wanted: Volunteers to Sponsor our Sunday Fellowship Hour**

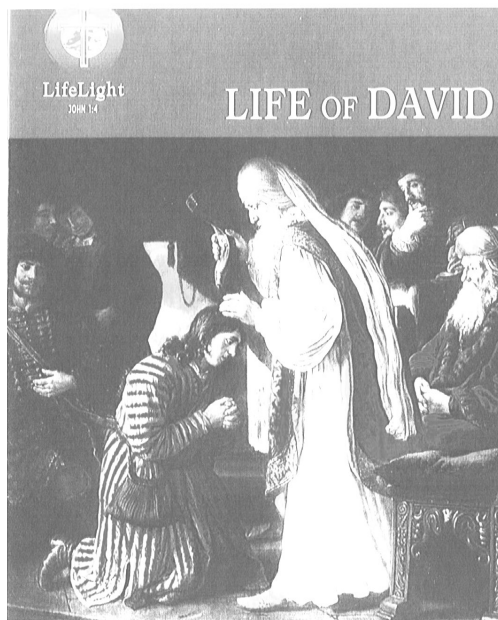

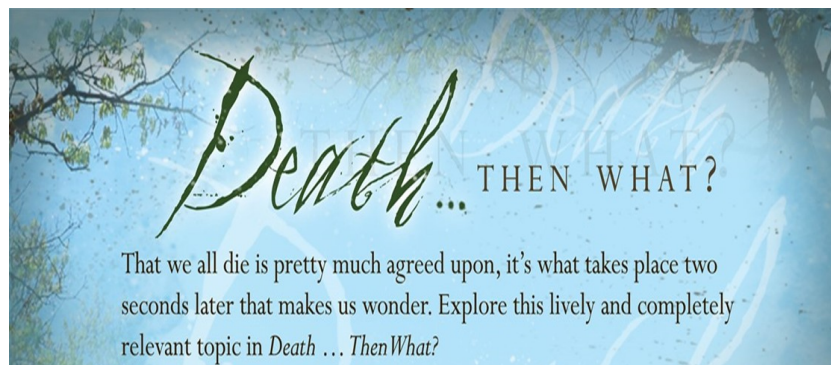


## **CHILDREN'S CHURCH RETURNS SUNDAY MORNING**

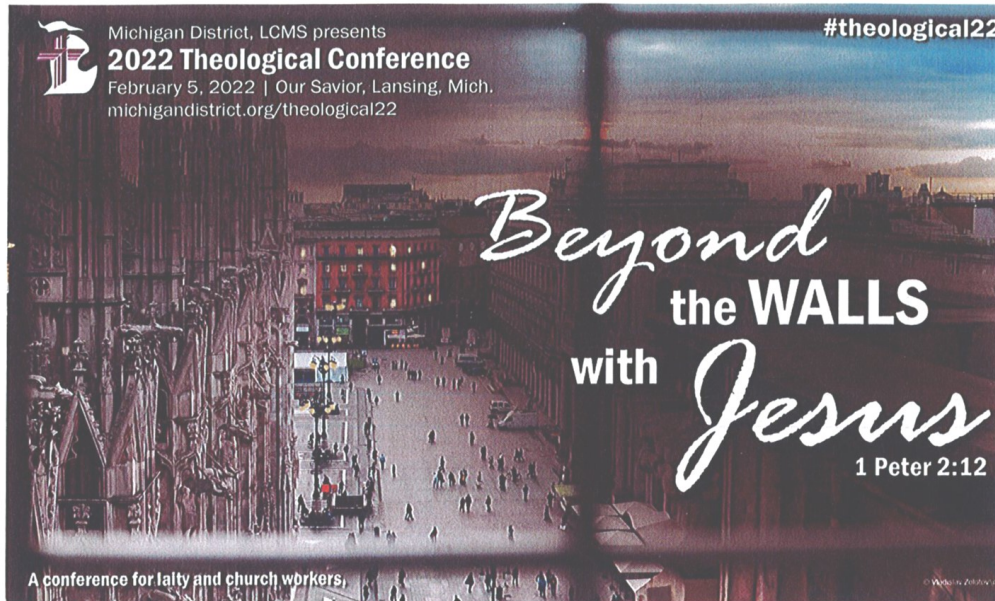
