This is one way in which we can show our strong PRO-LIFE support. Let's do what we can to make the crib overflow.






WOMEN'S BIBLE STUDY

Join us on Monday, at 1:00 pm.


A new Bible Study will begin on January 9th entitled "HEBREWS—The fulfillment of faith". This is a study of one of the most profound




Wanted: Volunteers to Sponsor our Sunday Fellowship Hour
