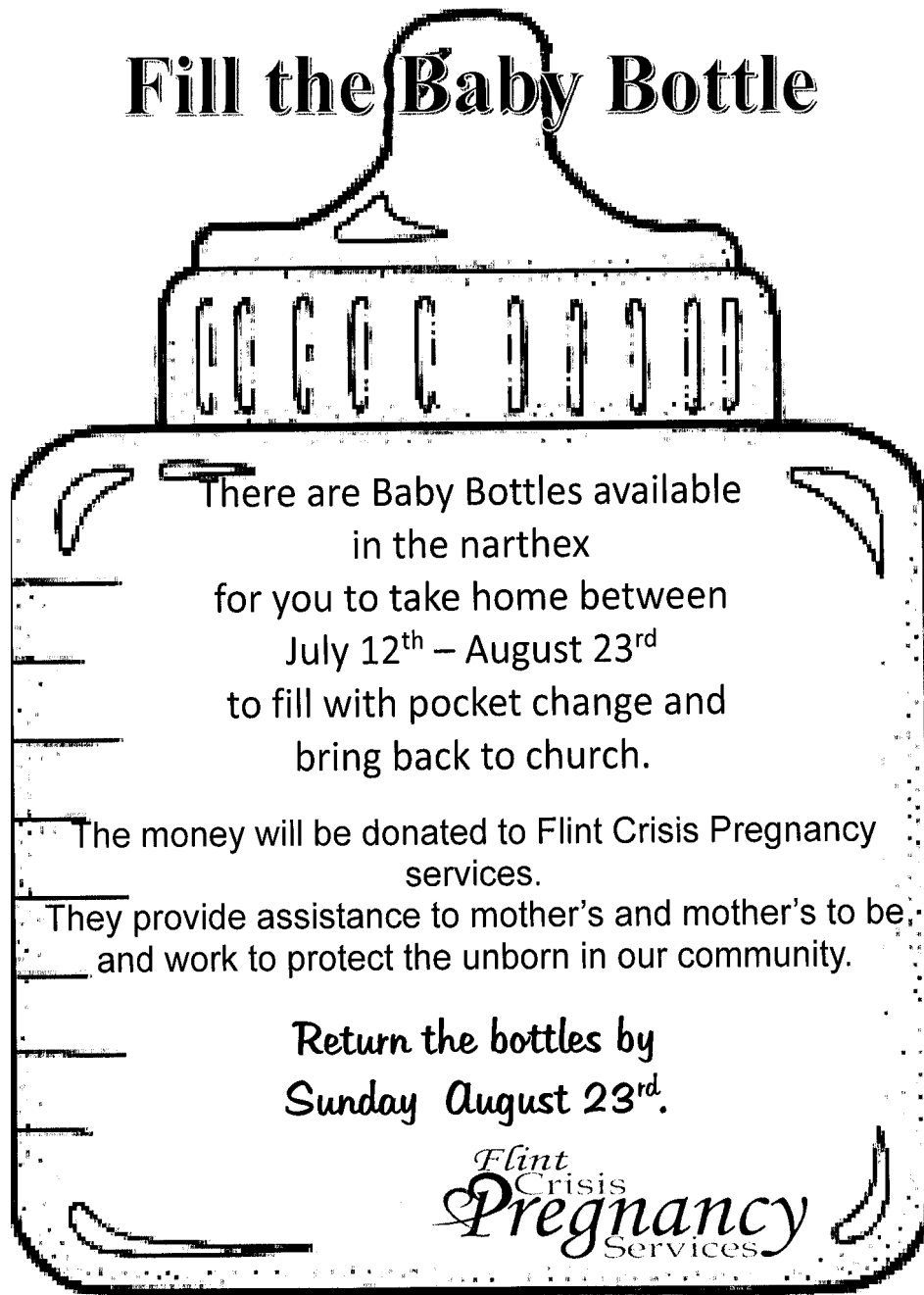
### **Help Needed at Franklin Mission:**

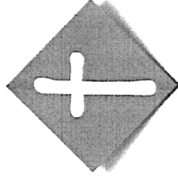

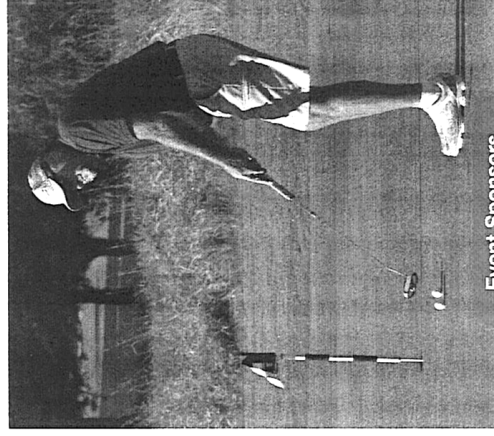

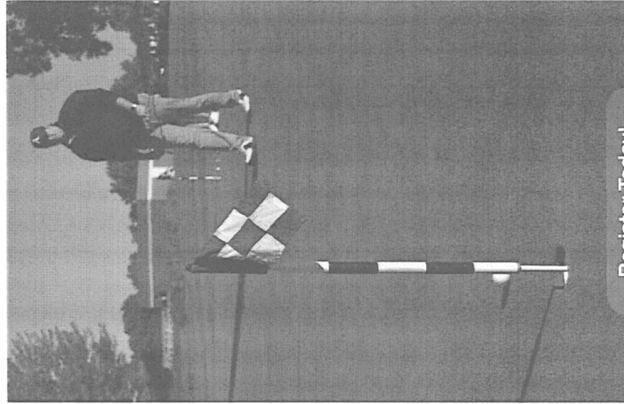
