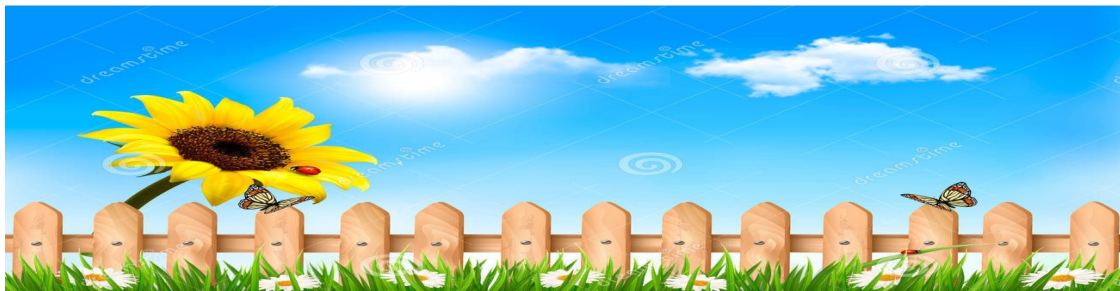

**CHILDREN'S CHURCH RETURNS SUNDAY MORNING**

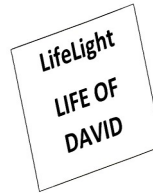

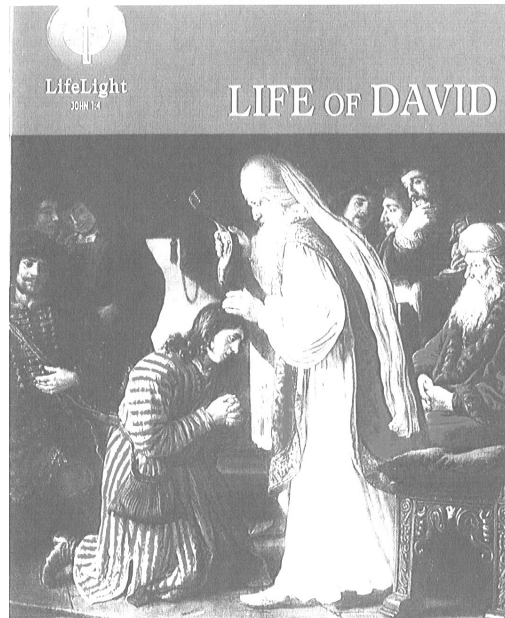

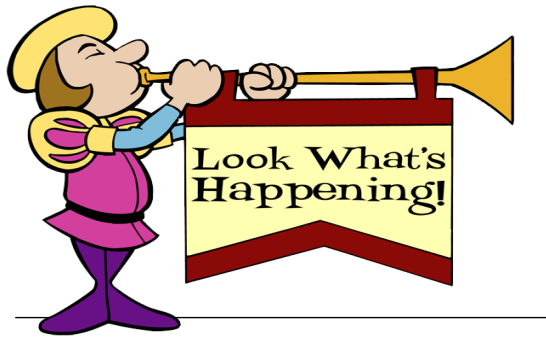
