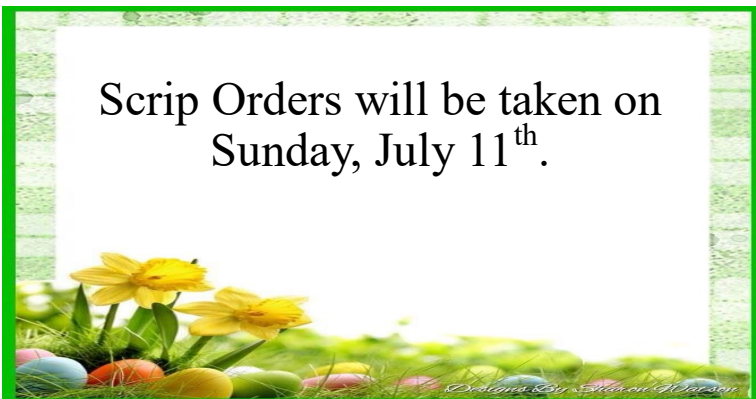

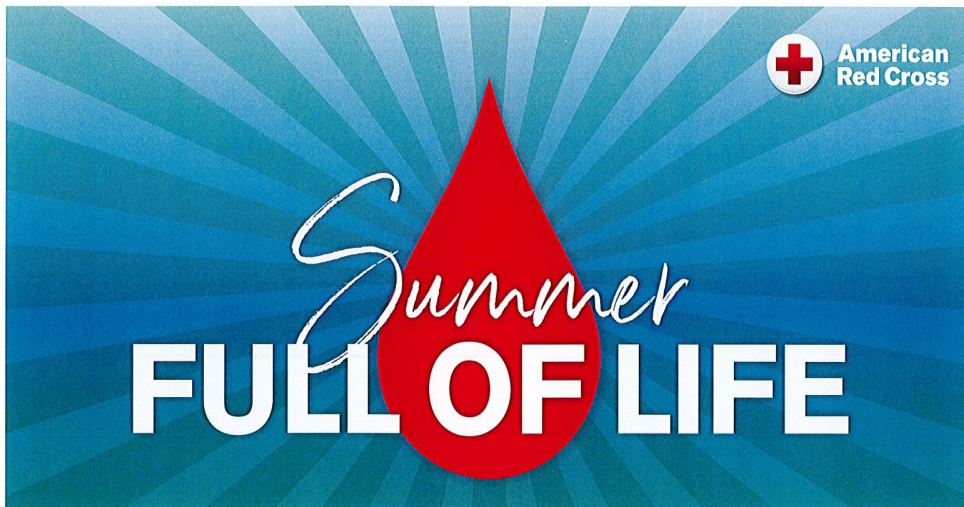

The **items they can still use** are baby wipes, shampoo & conditioner and small travel sizes of deodorant. They also always need all sizes of socks and underwear.

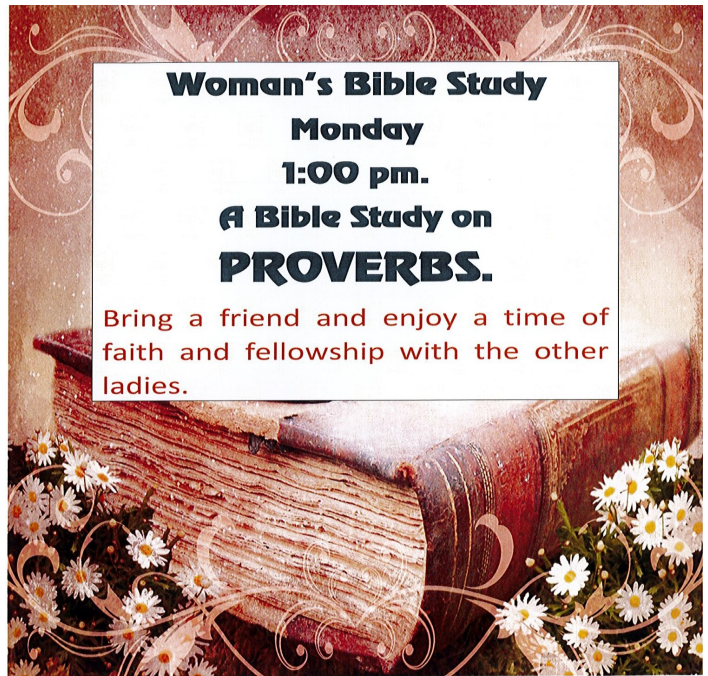
Luke Project 52 WANTED VOLUNTEERS

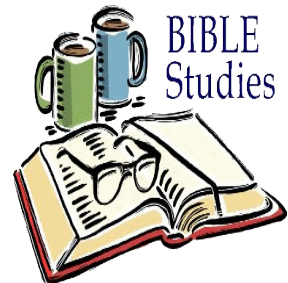
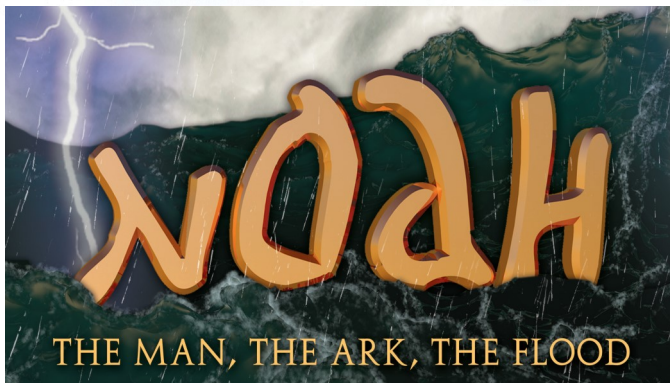
