The flowers on the Altar are in celebration this morning and were given to the glory of God, from Bonnie Jackson, in memory of Wm & Dorothy Orvis.

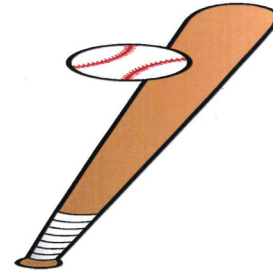

### **A WORD ABOUT THE OFFERING COLLECTED AT LOG:**

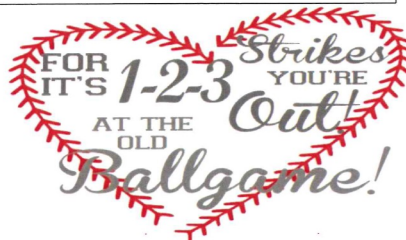

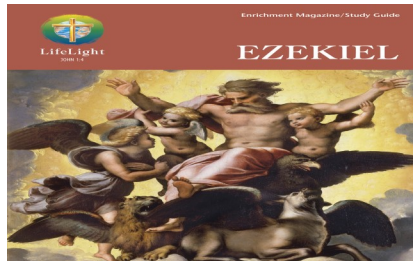

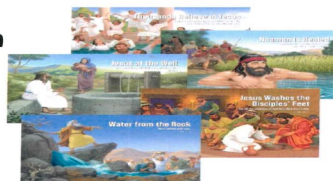
