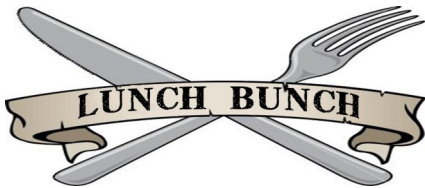
A table has been set up in the Narthex for you to sign up for the day and time you would like your picture taken. Sign up today!
