In order to offer this means of grace, while safeguarding the health and wellbeing of our members, the Elders and I announce the resumption of **Family Time Communion on Sunday, May 10<sup>th</sup>, 2020**. Following the schedule below we will allow groups of 20 or less individuals into the Sanctuary for a short service of Confession and Absolution and The Lord's Supper:

- 12:00 PM-12:30 PM Last names beginning with A-C
- 12:30 PM 1:00 PM Last names beginning with D-G
- 1:00 PM 1:30 PM Last names beginning with H-J
- 1:30 PM 2:00 PM Last names beginning with K-N
- 2:00 PM 2:30 PM Last names beginning with O-R
- 2:30 3:00 PM Last names beginning with S-Z
- Note: those who attend the public worship service at 10:00 AM may remain after that service has ended to receive the Lord's Supper as a short separate service.

Please arrive at the beginning of your time slot. The Elders will welcome you into the Sanctuary in groups of 10 families or less. The service should take 15-20 minutes, after which the Sanctuary will be wiped down, and then we will welcome the next group. Subsequent groups will be asked to wait in the Narthex, the Fellowship Hall, or in their cars to await their turn in order to observe the 6-foot distancing guideline.
