New Family Time Communion Schedule: Family Time Communion was attended by 5 members total over the three-hour schedule. We are going to continue offering Family Time Communion as an opportunity for those who would like to celebrate the Sacrament in a smaller group setting. But for now, until attendance mandates, we are going to scale back the schedule to the following beginning Sunday, May 17th, 2020:

- 12:00 PM-12:30 PM: Last names beginning with A-G
- 12:30 PM-1:00 PM: Last names beginning with H-N
- 1:00 PM 1:30 PM: Last names beginning with O-Z

This service of Confession and Absolution and The Sacrament takes approximately 15-20 minutes. We take time after the service is over to clear out the Sanctuary and wipe down the pews and Communion Rail. We will adjust as necessary to keep the limit of attendees under 20. Those waiting to attend the service can do so in the Narthex, or the Fellowship Hall observing the 6-feet distancing.


