
You would plan, purchase, set up and clean up. You can make, or buy treats.

FAM Jam LASTEST UPDATE POSTPONED

Please note that the fam Jam is **not cancelled**; rather, it is tentatively being **rescheduled** for this fall - on a date that will later be made public. We are currently in conversation with Jeff Roberts & Associates who represent Flame to ensure that this happens. Due to the current surge of COVID-19 cases across the state of Michigan, it has been decided that this would be the best course of action. When we started planning about year ago for our hip-hop festival centered around Luther's Small Catechism, we had hoped that by this summer Michigan would be able to safely hold outdoor community events; however, with these current conditions, it is likely that the MDHHS orders will remain in effect thru June, and we cannot, in good conscience, disobey these orders, and allow our Eastside neighborhood to be put at risk for the next large scale outbreak. We are asking you join us in prayer for the safety of our neighbors across the state of Michigan and the health workers who care for them, and that the infection and hospitalization rates of COVID 19 decrease locally and abroad, so that we might be able to safely gather, together once again.

Childcare - Part of the vision to 'Help Young Families Flourish' involves guidance and love for God's littlest lambs. Plans are underway to provide a daycare center for community members children at FAM. Contact Rachel if you would like to be part of this ministry in the future.

Clean & Green will be a combination of what they have done in the past and what was done during Covid. We would like Church teams to sign up to mow at least 1 Saturday during the summer.




Luke Project 52 WANTED VOLUNTEERS
