
5th Annual Devoted Fellowship Charity Golf Outing

Saturday, August 21, 2021. Registration begins June 1st. More information to follow.


Lamb of God's next time to serve at the Franklin Ave. Mission will be Tuesday, June 22nd & Thursday, June 24th.


