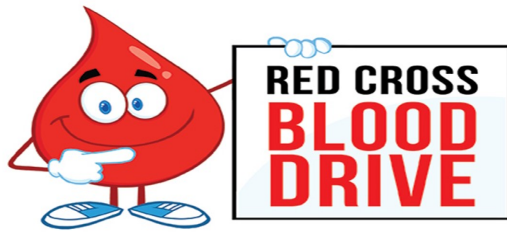
We have time. The Picture day has been rescheduled to Tuesday, July 21st & Wednesday, July 22nd.

This is a service of Confession and Absolution, and The Sacrament. It takes approximately 15 minutes. We take time afterwards to clean and wipe down the pews and Communion Rail. Even with this scaled back schedule there is room built in to have 2 separate services in each of the 30-minute blocks to safely accommodate all who show up. We will make adjustments accordingly so that the total number in the Sanctuary for each service is under 20. Those waiting their turn can do so in the Narthex, or the Fellowship Hall, observing the 6-foot distancing. The past two Sundays there hasn't been anyone who had to wait. I don't expect this to change in the near future.
