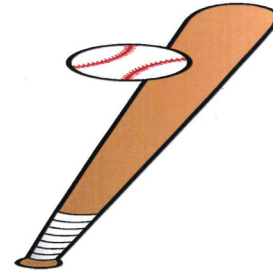

A WORD ABOUT THE OFFERING COLLECTED AT LOG:

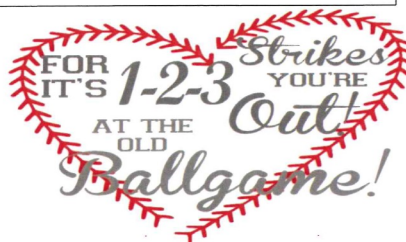

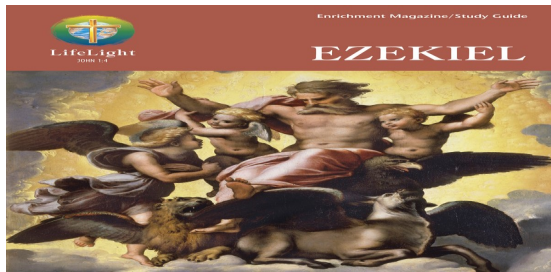
