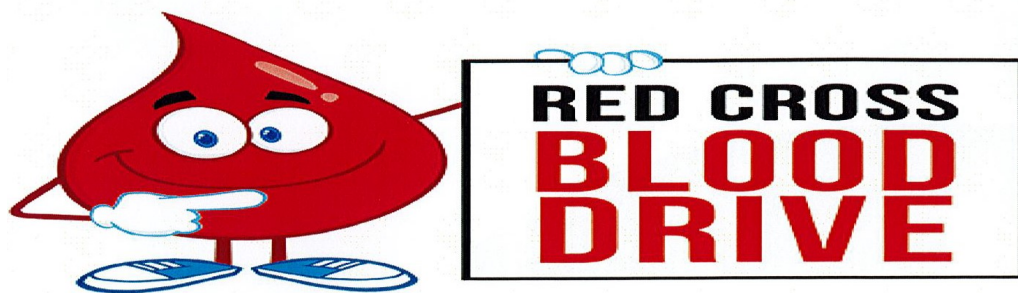
CHURCH COUNCIL

THRIVENT MEMBERS

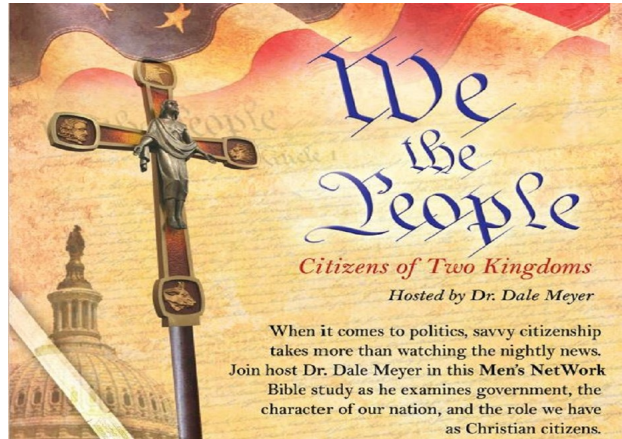
