## PROTECT MICHIGAN VALUES—END DISMEMBERMENT ABORTIONS. \*\* LAST SUNDAY TO SIGN\*\*

On the table in front of Pastor's office is a Petition to sign to end Dismemberment Abortions.

Please take a petition to sign and pass around to friends and family.

This petition drive is to initiate legislation that would make partial birth abortion illegal in Michigan. After enough voters signatures are gathered (approx. 400,000), this ban would become law with a simple majority vote in the House and Senate. The Michigan Legislators recently voted to approve such measures, but Governor Whitmer has promised to veto this legislation that they just passed. But if this petition is passed by House/Senate she will not have the ability to veto it. Nor will legislators be able to change the wording. It will become Law.
