

Brothers in Christ,

As you may know, Pastor Christian Jones of the Flint Mission Network has had some recent health issues, which has caused him to step back from active ministry. After seeking treatment for his health concerns he has been advised by his physician to move towards a less stressful type of ministry. We have received a letter from him stating that he has been in contact with the District Office, and will be reassigned to a vacant congregation until he receives a full-time call to serve as a pastor in a new ministry context. He has been a blessing to us all at the Mission, and will be greatly missed.

We, as the Board of Directors, fully intend to continue with all of the ministries that are currently happening here, and hope to meet with the District Office soon to request a call for another pastor to continue the ministry here. We will need a lot of support in the coming months to make ministry happen here.

These are some tangible ways of helping:

- Since Christian has been unable to go to various congregations and keep the needs of the Mission here in front of the people, we hope you will encourage your congregations to get involved and volunteer. The Diner is open Tuesdays and Thursdays 4:30 - 5:30, and help is always welcome.

 just engaging the people is helpful.
- Financial donations are critically important, also.
- A pastor is needed for a short worship service/Bible study on Thursdays at 5:30 p.m.
