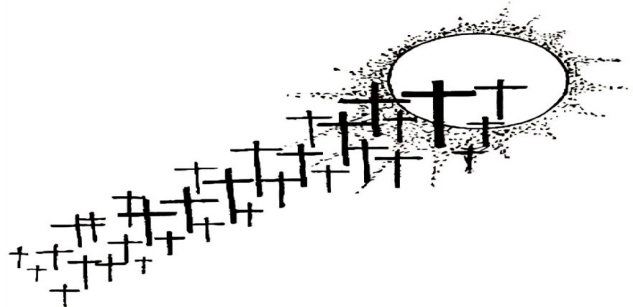
A WORD ABOUT THE OFFERING COLLECTED AT LOG:

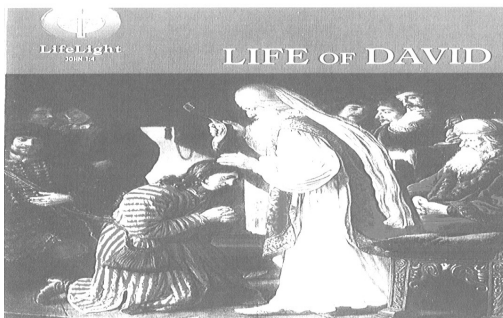

Please check your mailbox to see if you have anything in them. The mailboxes are in the hallway by the decorated bulletin board.



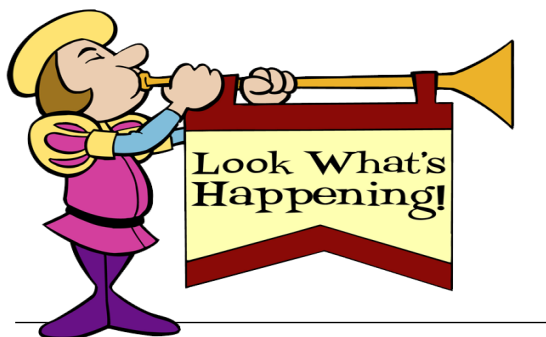

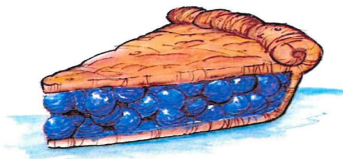

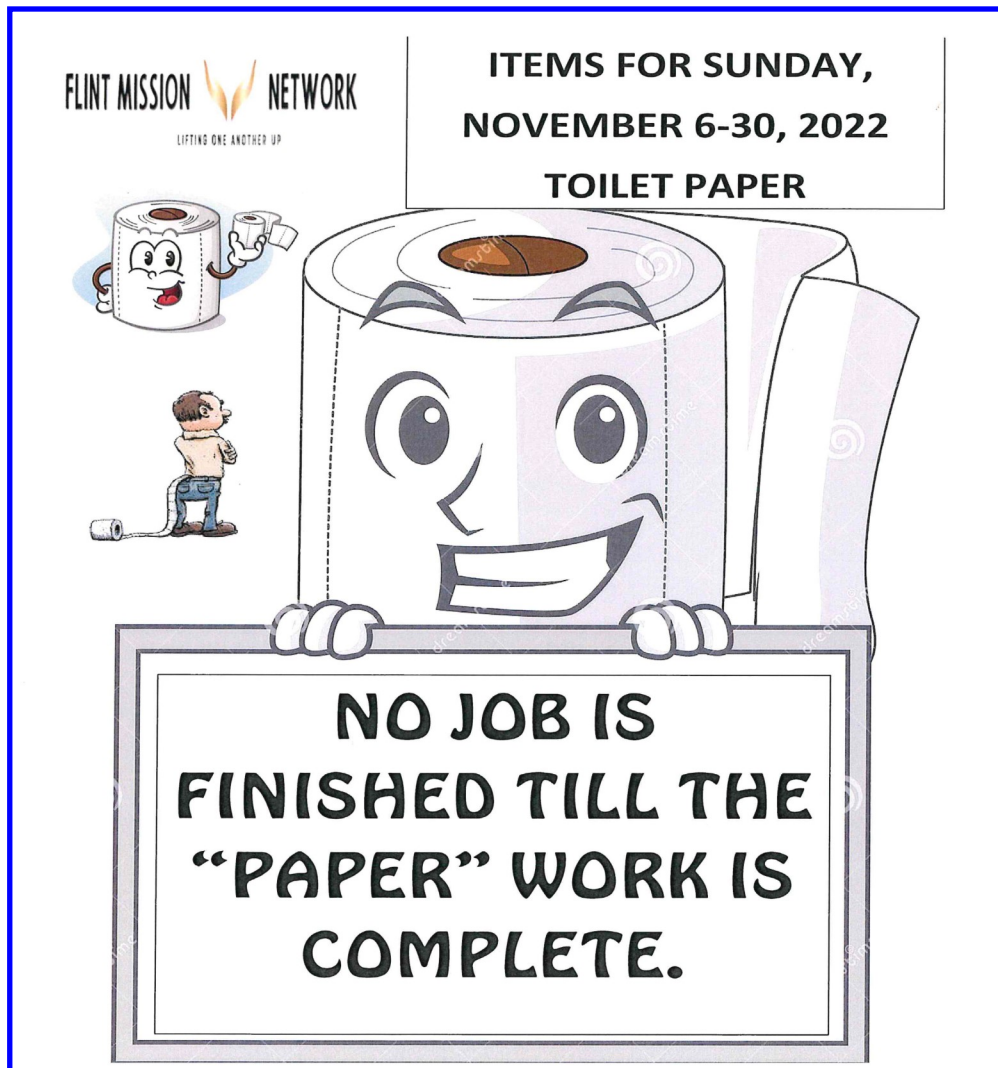
