

QUILTS+ON THE PEWS




PRIVATE HOME COMMUNION:

There are many areas in which you can support Franklin Avenue Mission and The Luke Clinic. Here is a short list of what is needed: Diaper Bags, Onesies, Sleepers, PJ's, Hooded Baby Towels, Receiving Blankets, No Scratch Mittens, Socks, Bibs, Burp Clothes, Hats, Wash Clothes, Pacifiers, Nail Clippers, Diaper Rash Cream, High Chairs, Strollers, Boppy Pillows, Teething Rings All clothing needs are 0-3 month size. Most items can be gently used or new. Please use your discretion on the condition if a used item. All donations will be greatly appreciated by the families we will be serving. "Many hands make light work" we have all heard this saying before and it sure does apply when it comes to raising a baby. We will need medical volunteers and regular volunteers to make this clinic a success. This is a minimal time commitment of 2 days a month. 
The Pfizer (maybe the Moderna & Johnson) shot will be available also.
