**We must observe the Governor's mandated limit of 10 people gathering inside from separate households.** Also please wear masks.

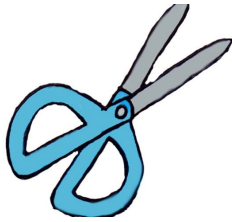
## **CHURCH COUNCIL**

#### **COMING IN OCTOBER**

We are planning on starting a Youth Confirmation Program soon for 7<sup>th</sup> and 8<sup>th</sup> graders, and also for those who are of High School age who have not yet been confirmed and desire to become members of this congregation. This will include class time, occasional service projects, as well as fun activities. They will be asked to help out in some manner during our Worship Services such as serving as an acolyte, directing parishioners during the Communion Service (Gatekeeping), assisting with our Live-Streaming, wiping down the pews before service, wiping down the Communion Rails during the Communion Service, reading one of the Scripture Lessons during worship (depending on their comfort level). 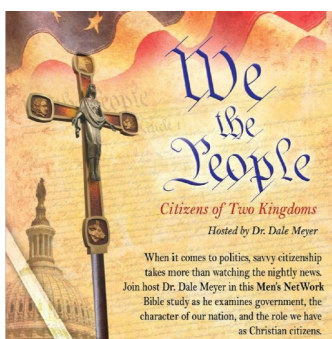
**From the American Red Cross:
