

LifeLight Worship; Bible Study on Ezekiel

Please join us Wednesday, at 10:00 AM in the Fellowship Hall for our LifeLight Bible Study on the Old Testament Book of Ezekiel. Ezekiel was the prophetic voice of the LORD to the Jewish exiles in Babylon. His first task was to dispel any false notions that the temple and the city of Jerusalem would be preserved from the destruction the LORD had foretold. Then, after that has come to pass, Ezekiel was the LORD's voice of hope for the restoration of His people back in their homeland. Ezekiel speaks to the Church today in our exile in the broken sinful world as we await the final restoration in Eternal Life.

I invite you to join us in the Fellowship Hall Wednesday Evening, at 7:00 PM for our Bible Study Series based on the TV Series "The Chosen". provide candy for their own table.**




