

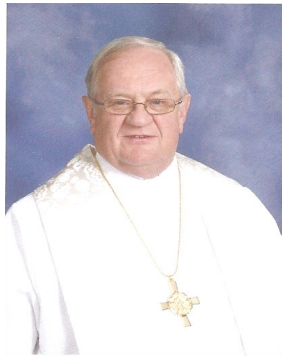

fellowship room.

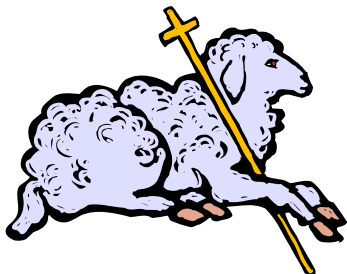
